ORDER ON PENALTY AND COSTS

THIS HEARING was held on February 12-16, May 1, and December 14, 2018, in Thornhill, Ontario.

ON READING the evidence filed, and upon hearing the submissions of the College and the submissions of the Member:

A. THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE ORDERS THE FOLLOWING PENALTY:

1. Ms. Yan is required to appear before a panel of the Discipline Committee immediately following the hearing of this matter to be reprimanded, with the fact of the reprimand and a summary of the reprimand to appear on the public register of the College;

2. The Registrar is hereby directed to suspend Ms. Yan's Certificate of Registration for a

period of ten (10) months.

3. The Registrar is directed to impose the following specified terms, conditions and

limitations on Ms. Yan's Certificate of Registration:

a. Requiring that Ms. Yan provide proof, acceptable to the Registrar, of successful

completion of the PROBE ethics and boundaries course, which is to be taken at

her own expense, within six (6) months of the date of this order.

b. Requiring that Ms. Yan provide proof, acceptable to the Registrar, of successful

completion of the College's Record-Keeping E-Workshop, which is to be taken at

her own expense, within six (6) months of the date of this order.

c. Requiring that the Member participate in a College Assessment focusing on

ethical and record-keeping issues, at her own expense, within six (6) months of

resuming her practice following the suspension set out in paragraph 2 above. The

cost of the assessment shall not exceed \$500.00.

d. Requiring Ms. Yan to complete, to the satisfaction of the Registrar, a 1500 word

essay, on the importance of ethics and professionalism in the practice of

Traditional Chinese Medicine, within six (6) months of the date of this order.

4. Ms. Yan is hereby required to pay a fine of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) payable to the

Minister of Finance, within six (6) months of the date of this order.

5. Ms. Yan is hereby required to pay the College costs in the amount of sixty-five thousand

dollars (\$65,000.00), within four (4) years from the date of this order on a payment

schedule to be agreed upon between the College and the Member.
