## **Policy Statement**

The Quality Assurance (QA) Committee assigns Peer Assessors to conduct Peer and Practice Assessments (PPA). The Committee will conduct due diligence to ensure that a conflict of interest does not exist for the member and the assigned Peer Assessor(s).

## **Procedure**

- 1. The QA Committee shall assign a Peer Assessor(s) to conduct a PPA. Factors to be considered during assignment include:
  - a. The member's registered profession, i.e., a Peer Assessor registered as an Acupuncturist will not assess a member who is registered as a Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioner but can assess a member who is registered as an Acupuncturist;
  - b. Geographical location;
  - c. Practice setting; and
  - d. Language.
- 2. The member and the Peer Assessor(s) will receive notice of the assignment and the identification information of the other party.
- 3. The member and the Peer Assessor(s) shall, within 14 days, declare whether or not a conflict of interest exists.
- 4. If no conflict of interest is declared, the PPA shall be scheduled.
- 5. If a conflict of interest is declared, the QA Committee shall assign another Peer Assessor to conduct the PPA.
- 6. The procedure will return to paragraph 2 of this policy and repeat until no conflicts of interest are declared.

## **Legislative Context**

Section 7 of the Quality Assurance Program Regulation (O. Reg 28/13) of the Traditional Chinese Medicine Act, 2006.
